

„Unconventional teaching methods” – group I

Within the project “International mobility of school education staff” co-financed by the European Union in the framework of the European Social Fund, Operational Programme Knowledge Education Development, the first group of teachers from Zespół Szkół Mechanicznych nr 2 im.
